Bible Study With Rev. Laurie

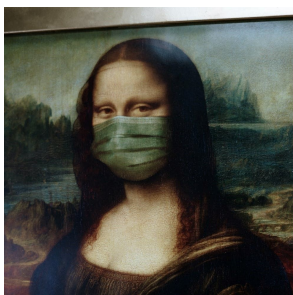
Thursday, August 6 | 3:30 pm

Contra Costa County Approves Fines for Health Order Violations

If you're not wearing a mask, it will now cost you. The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors passed an ordinance that allows officials to fine people and businesses for violating pandemic health orders, such as not wearing masks and not practicing social distancing. For individuals, the fines are \$100 for a first offense, \$200 for a second, and \$500 for a third. And so, mask up, stay healthy, and avoid fines!

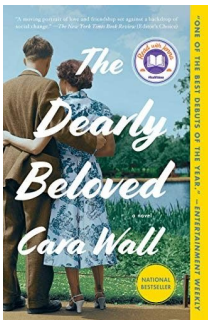
Parish Office Hours

On Sunday, July 12, we learned that our former rector, Fr. Bob was received into the arms of God's grace after a long battle with cancer. Condolence cards can be sent to:

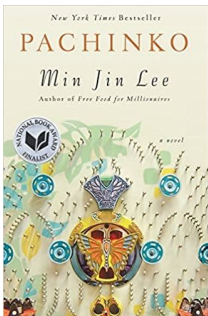
