Thursday, November 5 | 3:30 pm

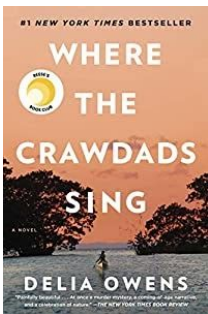

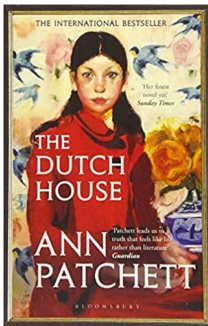
